It looks like all of the pieces are finally coming together with the re-development of our range on Rocky Branch Road.

As we progress with the construction phase of the range it is inevitable that we will have to shut the range down while workers are on the premises. With the price of gas hovering over \$4.00 per gallon, I would suggest checking on the web page [www.erml-gunclub.org](http://www.erml-gunclub.org) for the closure dates and times before going to the range. The internet is the fastest method of communicating events, time-sensitive information and closures of the range.

Our first step in the re-design process is a lead clean-up, which will take place sometime during the months of August or September. The range will be closed for 5-8 days during this clean-up. The next step will be to seek DRC approval and having permits pulled, and the final stage will be the construction of the range itself. This process could take 2-3 months, depending on weather and the availability of machinery. (We will try to work on one end of the Range so that the other end remains open.)
